<p>This module covers <i>Tawhid</i>, discussing Allah's existence, Unity and Attributes. It also covers the creation of the universe, angels, jinn and man, and the history of <i>Nabi Adam</i> and his children. Key concepts of <i>tawbah</i> and <i>istighfār</i>, <i>du'a</i> and <i>munājāt</i>, as well as <i>salāh</i> are also covered here, as they form the basis of our relationship with Allah.</p>		<p>Having created us, Allah continues to nurture and guide us. This module covers the <i>lutf</i> and <i>adālah</i> of Allah, and explores the understanding of the various schools of Islamic theology, especially in relation to <i>Adālah</i>. It discusses Divine guidance through <i>Nubuwwah</i>, and the <i>ulul 'azm</i> Prophets. The Qur'an is also covered in this module.</p>		<p>This module is a continuation of the concept of Divine guidance, focusing on <i>Rasulullah (s)</i>: his life, his <i>seerah</i> and <i>sunnah</i>, and his family, including the immaculate ladies <i>Khadija (a)</i> and <i>Fatimah (a)</i>.</p>		<p>This module focuses on the divinely appointed successors of <i>Rasulullah (s)</i>. It discusses <i>Imāmah</i> and <i>Khilāfah</i>, the concept of divine appointment, and the qualities of such <i>Imāms</i>. It covers lives of the <i>Aimma</i> of <i>Ahl al-Bayt (a)</i>, and explores key concepts relating to <i>Imāmah</i> and <i>wilayah</i>.</p>		<p>This module is dedicated to the <i>Imām</i> of our time, <i>Imām al-Mahdi (a)</i>. It covers the history of <i>Imām al-Mahdi</i>, the concept of <i>ghaybah</i>, the long life of the <i>Imām</i>, and the challenges faced during the <i>ghaybah</i>. It also covers the important subject of <i>ijtihād</i> and <i>taqlid</i>, and explores the lives of some prominent 'ulema'.</p>		<p>This module is a continuation of the roadmap to self-purification but at societal level. Islam is not a religion of individuals. It is a religion of a community and a global <i>Ummah</i>. <i>Al-amr bil ma'rūf</i> and <i>nahi anil munkar</i> symbolise the social aspect of the community: we have to promote goodness in society and prevent social evils.</p>		<p>This is a standalone module under the section "The Return".
