



Would love to have notes on upcoming class so I can be better prepared for it.


it would be very helpful if the sessions are recorded as the extra information discussed really is helpful


Am unable to go through recordings in my mobile set

i would prefer if more examples of different kinds of ahadith are given in relevance to the topic learnt and wouldn't mind doing homework for strenghthening my knowledge



potentially a hawza level in depth - for people like me who live away from London such studies are not easily accessible.


I understand WF are planning other sessions on other topics too - I really look forward to this.


Gender



Age




Which Jamaat are you a member of (if any)?
