Hadith:

Holy Prophet Muhammad al Mustafa (s.a.w.w.) said:

"Whoever likes his daily bread to be increased and his death to be put off should visit his relations of kin". [Reference: Mishkat Ul-Anwar, Ch. 15 , Hadees 881]

Imām Muhammad ibn ‘Alī al-Bāqir (A.S.) said:

“Visiting the relations of kin will purify your deeds, fend off calamities, increase your wealth, ease the reckoning, and put off death.” [Reference: Mishkat Ul-Anwar, Ch. 15 , Hadees 876]

Imām Ja'far ibn Muhammad al-Sādiq (A.S.) said:

"Maintain relations with your kin even if it be by offering them a drink of water. The best way to maintain relations is to refrain from hurting them in any way." [Reference: al-Kafi, v. 2,p. 151, no. 9]

Holy Prophet Muhammad al Mustafa (s.a.w.w.) said:

"Among the various sins, injustice and cutting off relationships are such that one who commits these is punished in this world itself. Apart from this the punishment for these sinners has already been prepared in the Hereafter". [Reference: Greater Sins Vol 1, part 3, page 160]

Holy Prophet Muhammad al Mustafa (s.a.w.w.) said:

"Verily the good deed to be rewarded the fastest is reconciliation with one's kin..". [Reference: al-Kafi, v. 2, p. 152, no. 15]

Imām ‘Alī an-Naqī (‘Alī al-Hādī) (AS) said:

"When Allāh allowed [Prophet] Musa son of Amran (A.S.) to converse with Him, Musa (A.S.) asked, "My God, what is the reward of one who maintains relations with his kin?" He replied, "O Musa, I delay the appointed time of his death, and ease the pangs of death for him." [Reference: Amali al-Saduq, p. 173, no. 8]

Imām `Alī ibn Husayn (a.s.) in his advice to his son al-Baqir (AS), said:

"Beware of befriending one who has cut off relations with his kin, for verily I have seen him cursed in the Book of Allāh, Mighty and Exalted, on three different occasions." [Reference: Bihar al-Anwar, v. 74, v. 2, p. 377, no. 7]

Amir al-Mu'minin Imām ‘Alī ibn Abī Tālib (A.S) said:

"If you want to cut off relations with your brother make sure to leave a place for him in your heart, so he can return to it one day when he so wishes.". [Reference: Nahj al-Balagha, Letter 31]

Holy Prophet Muhammad al Mustafā (S.A.W.W) said:

"If you want to be happy the whole year, reconcile with your kin." [Reference: Bihar al-Anwar, v. 74, p. 103, no. 61]
